1. Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by President Donnie McMahon at 1:00 pm.

- 2. Public Notice: This meeting was publicly noticed for FloridaWest on June 6th, 2019.
- 3. Public Comment: There was none.
- 4. Welcome to Interns: President Donnie McMahon welcomed Caleb Prine as the Business Development intern from the University of Southern Miss and Alyvia Waite as the Marketing intern from the University of West Florida.
- 5. Action Items
 - a. Approve May 21st, 2019 Minutes

b. Approval of May 2019 Financials

6. Discussion Items

a. Old Business

1. PEDC Board Appointment Policy: Donnie McMahon suggested that the FloridaWest President nominate suggestions for these appointments. The appointments will be for two years and staggered. Lewis Bear would like it to not necessarily be members of the board as appointees. Lewis Bear asked if the appointments had term limits. Margaret Stopp shared that she believes there are no term limits. Donnie McMahon nominated Lewis Bear for a two-year term to expire in 2021 and Dave Hoxeng for a one-year term to expire in 2020 in order to adhere to the required staggered appointments. Approved unanimously by the board.

b. ED Project Updates

- 1. Cybersecurity Specialist Update: Melissa Stoker shared the interviews of the top four candidates are being scheduled for July 2nd.
- 2. Co:Lab: Patrick Rooney welcomed the New Co:Lab Office Manager, Casey Campbell. He also gave an update on Co:Lab. Occupancy is at approximately 70% with two potential new tenants in the pipeline. A tenant selection committee meeting will be scheduled in the next few weeks. Pending approval, the two potential new tenants would get us closer to the 80% occupancy. In addition, the old IRIS space with the 9 workstations is being considered for alternative options to increase utilization.
- 3. Business Development: Danita Andrews shared that Scott Luth is currently at the Paris Air Show. Danita Andrews recently visited New York with several other local partners for site consultant visits with backgrounds in manufacturing. She also attended SelectUSA in Washington DC along with 3000 other participants to court foreign companies looking to do business in the US. We have qualified 5 potential projects for our region and will be answering RFPs due between this Friday and next Wednesday. Danita Andrews also shared that Project Spruce is scheduled for tomorrow. They are a manufacturer from Brazil and are looking at space at Elyson Industrial park. Danita Andrews indicated that while State RFPs are down, site visits are up.
- 4. Marketing: Sena Maddison shared that she met with the city, county, and Visit Pensacola on ADA Compliance. Rebecca Ferguson shared that the ADA compliance issue arose from a recent lawsuit. Sena Maddison shared that the final version of the video previously shared is coming along and should be ready next week. She also pointed out the Q2 Report and FloridaWest briefing that is included in the board packet. Alyvia Waite is working on success stories to promote positive Pensacola experiences.
- 5. Workforce: Jeff Dyer provided an update on the IDN Grant. He and Scott Luth traveled to Cleveland recently for the first convening with the other four grant recipients. They will be working with Burning Glass, a data analysis company in the coming months. The first phase is a labor market/economic study. The second phase will focus on strategy, and the third phase will focus on implementation. The next meeting will be in Spokane, WA in September. Jeff Dyer updated on the SkillBridge program in that the website went live on June 14th. He did some additional research on the Troops to Teachers program. In

2016, the program was halted due to inappropriate funding usage. In 2018, Florida got the grant reapproved, with processes and procedures reestablished in January 2019.

- c. Membership: President Donnie McMahon provided an update on the recent visits made as well as the upcoming scheduled visits.
- **d. ED Calendar Review:** Sena Maddison referenced the provided calendar in the board packet.
- e. New Business:
 - 1. Lewis Bear Jr requested support at the Budget COW meeting beginning on June 25th at 8:30 am.
 - 2. John Hutchinson shared that Mark Faulkner is the newly elected President of First Place Partners. There is an entire new board. The sites and buildings are live on the website. They are also working on a two-county brochure for FloridaWest and Santa Rosa EDO to use.

President Donnie McMahon adjourned the meeting 1:47 pm.
