FloridaWest EDA is in the process of finalizing agreements with state and local government, Academic Institutions, Federal agencies and industry partners to leverage the emerging cyber ecosystem established by the Florida Cyber Coast Strategy Consortium.

Pensacola FL is home to a rapidly growing cyber cluster; DHS, NSA, DoD, state and commercial operations, research and development are attracting highly qualified technicians from around the country. To support this cluster a robust and comprehensive workforce development syndicate has been established to meet the needs at all organizational and operational levels. The proposed center piece of this emerging ecosystem is the Pensacola Cyber Operations Center or P'COC.

The P'COC facility will provide work spaces, connectivity, SCIF space, research labs, classrooms, cyber exercise facilities to support revenue generating leveraged cyber services offered on a global level.

The industry partner will be able to take advantage of the regions: low cost of living, robust talent pipeline, desirable communities, and low cost facilities collocated with key Federal/DOD clients, creating a highly competitive edge in the Cyber Services market.
