Baskerville-Donovan, Inc. is under contract with PEDC to complete the referenced project. The contract agreement was signed on February 22, 2022, and allowed 494 days to complete all work defined in the scope of services with a final deliverable date of July 1, 2023. BDI has completed work up to Task 4 of the agreement and cannot continue work until approval of the right-of-way agreement between Ascend Materials and Escambia County. Tasks 5 and 6 of our agreement remain to be completed and allow for 164 days.

With this letter we respectfully request an extension of 180 days to our agreement to allow for closure on the right-of-way agreement and completion of Tasks 5 and 6.

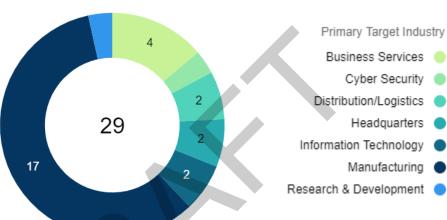

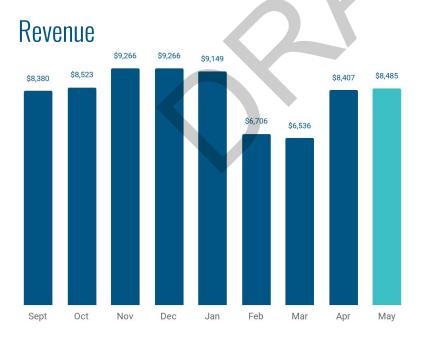

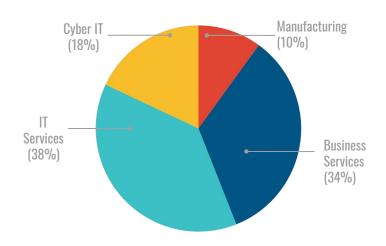
